In-patients Dispensary Licence Conditions

Apart from the General Conditions of Licence for Pharmacy Licences, the following conditions shall also apply for In-patients Dispensary Licences:

1. This licence is for an in-patients pharmacy only, which forms part of the premises of a licensed hospital.

2. Furthermore this licence is valid only for pharmacy services which must be rendered solely to the hospital of which it is physically forming part of and will no longer remain valid if the hospital licence is no longer valid.

3. Upon discharge patients may not be dispensed more than three days supply of medicinal products for continuation of treatment at home. Further supplies must be bought from the retail community pharmacies.

4. For emergency cases where patients are seen / treated but are not hospital admitted, the in-patients pharmacy may dispense a maximum of one undivided packet of a medicinal product. Further supplies must be bought from the retail community pharmacies.
