# 3. How to take Panadol Extra Soluble tablets

Panadol Extra Soluble tablets should be dissolved in at least half a tumbler of water.

## Adults, elderly and children aged 12

years and over: Take 2 tablets, up to 4 times daily as required

Children under 12 years: Do not give to children under 12 years.

- Do not take more frequently
- than every 4 hours. Do not take more than 8 tablets
- in 24 hours Do not exceed the stated dose.
- This product should be used only when clearly necessary. If symptoms persist consult your
- doctor.
- Prolonged use except under medical supervision may be harmful.
- If your symptoms continue or your headache becomes persistent, see vour doctor. If you take too many tablets Immediate medical advice should be sought in

the event of an overdose, even if you feel well, because of the risk of delayed, serious liver damage.

### 4. Possible side effects

Like all medicines, Panadol Extra Soluble tablets can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them.

#### Stop taking this medicine and tell your doctor immediately if:

- Very Rare (affects less than 1 in 10,000 people) • You experience allergic reactions such as skin rash or itching, sometimes with breathing problems or swelling of the lips, tongue,
- throat or face. • You experience a skin rash or peeling, or mouth ulcers.
- · You have previously experienced breathing problems with aspirin or non-steroidal antiinflammatories and experience a similar reaction with this product.
- You experience unexpected bruising or bleeding.
- You experience changes in blood tests that measure the function of your liver.

Other side effects include: insomnia, restlessness, anxiety, irritability, headaches, upset stomach, palpitations, nervousness and dizziness

If you do get any side effects, even those not mentioned in this leaflet, tell your doctor or pharmacist.

## 5. How to store Panadol Extra Soluble tablets

Keep out of the reach and sight of children. Do not store above 25°C.

Do not use this medicine after the expiry date (EXP) shown on the carton and blisters. The expiry date refers to the last day of that month. Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help to protect the environment.

## 6. Further information

Panadol Extra Soluble Effervescent Tablets. Flat, white tablets with bevelled edges, plain on one side, breakline on the other. The tablet can be divided into equal halves. Active ingredient Each tablet contains

Paracetamol 500mg and Caffeine 65mg. Other ingredients Sorbitol, saccharin sodium, sodium hydrogen carbonate, povidone, sodium laurilsulfate, dimeticone, citric acid (anhydrous) and sodium carbonate (anhydrous).

Packs of Panadol Extra Soluble contains 12 or 24 tablets in blister strips. Not all pack sizes may be marketed.
