The Inspectorate and Enforcement Directorate within the Medicines Authority were informed of a Medicinal Product Defect dated 26th September 2006 by Spanish Agency for Medicines & HealthCare Products. The reason for the defect is that some batches had out of specification tretinoin content in continuous stability tests carried out.

The recall is being carried out under the supervision of the Medicines Authority and has been classified as a Class 2 recall up to pharmacy level.
