
BEFORE YOU BEGIN

- Read all instructions for use thoroughly.
- · You should establish a regular treatment schedule, even when travelling.
- Make sure you have all the supplies that you will need (refer to the images below).
- Check the expiration dates on all vials.
- Do not use if expired or left at room temperature for more than 24 hours.
- Wash your hands with soap.
- Use an alcohol swab to clean the surface where you will be preparing product.

Please use this mat along with the *Step-by-step guide* and/or *Package leaflet* and *Self-administration DVD* to prepare your Nplate[®] injection. You may be required to use more than one injection of Nplate[®]. If your doctor has instructed you to take more than one injection of Nplate[®], follow the steps as defined in the *Step-by-step guide* to complete your prescribed dose of product using a new self-administration kit(s).



Store product vials in their carton to protect from light until use. This medicine may be removed from the refrigerator for a maximum period of 24 hours at room temperature (up to 25°C). It must be returned to the refrigerator for storage longer than 24 hours. Your healthcare provider may recommend a different needle for injection.
