The medicinal products **Germoloids suppositories and Germoloids ointment** with the above batch numbers, are being recalled up to pharmacy level by the local distributor under the supervision of the Medicines Authority. This recall is being affected following an inspection held at an active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) manufacturing site in Italy which was found to be GMP non-compliant. As a consequence, all finished products containing active ingredients with specific batch numbers which were being manufactured at the Italian site are being recalled.

Remaining stocks of the affected products are to be quarantined immediately and returned to your supplier.
